
Migration of On-Premise Exchange to Exchange Online

The Process:

The process of migrating your on-premise Exchange to O365/Exchange Online is quite simple. It's a multi-step process:

- Provision online user licenses as appropriate so that the new users have an Exchange online account
- 2. Alias created in O365 Admin Center to prepare for final DNS move (so the "universe" knows to send emails to Exchange Online vs on-premise server
 - a. Will need to "verify" the domain used in the Alias by loading your TXT (or MX) record from your website DNS hosting provider



- 3. Remote migration wizard started to begin sync of on-premise emails to Exchange Online
 - a. Process usually takes a few days, so good to start in the middle of the week and plan the final cutover for the weekend
- 4. Once all emails sync'd in step 2, you may complete the final DNS move by adding your MX record to Exchange online

The Timeline:

It's variable depending upon how many email accounts you need to migrate, but it's typically under 1 week.

The Cost:
